## Lee Rhiannon and Alice Mantel

Senator Lee Rhiannon represents the Australian Greens in the portfolios of Local Government, International Aid & Development, Democracy, and Animal Welfare.

Lee trained as a zoologist and botanist. In the 1990s, she co-founded and led AID/WATCH which scrutinises Australia's overseas aid program. She was co-ordinator of the NSW Coalition for Gun Control and member of the NSW Government's Women's Advisory Council.

Lee was a Greens MLA in the NSW Upper House from 1999 -2010, actively pursuing reform in areas like the environment, education, transport and industrial relations. Her Democracy4Sale project continues to expose how donations distort democracy across Australia. She recently worked to secure senate voting reform for federal elections.

Lee has also worked closely with local communities to build strong campaigns on:

- developing a future beyond coal mining,
- better funded public services in education, health and transport
- jobs based on a sustainable economy,
- stronger environmental protection,
- more open, transparent and accountable government.



As a lawyer, Alice Mantel has worked in criminal, civil, and family law, and represented diverse and disadvantaged people in our justice system.

As the Greens candidate for Reid, she stands for evidence-based policies that promote progressive government and respond to economic, environmental and social challenges.
