Alysha Hardy is a Social Justice and Business Administration student with passion for housing equality, environmental preservation and local public transport and amenities.



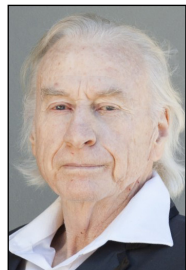
James Okeby supports effective and sustainable housing and development. He has practical experience of the community benefits of proactive infrastructure planning.

Support affordable housing

The Greens will encourage Council to expand genuinely affordable housing and increase social housing, including public housing. Our community needs appropriate housing for older and disabled people and young families. We need medium density developments with open space and more community facilities, **not** more high density construction.

Prioritise environmentally sustainable policies

The Greens will make environmental sustainability a priority in every new Council policy and housing development. Housing codes and standards, management of public land, water usage, investment of public funds, and procurement standards must be based on principles of sustainable population and consumption. The Greens will protect our green spaces and continue to campaign to make Parramatta River swimmable again.

Council support to fill public transport gaps

The Greens are campaigning for a direct bus route between Drummoyne and Concord Hospital via Five Dock and Concord shopping centres. We oppose the privatisation of inner west buses. We will ensure that Council does more to promote transport solutions including cycleways and links to trains, buses and ferries.

Democratic councils not forced amalgamations

我们需要民主的地方议会，而不是强迫性的统一。

The Greens have consistently fought against the State Government forced Council merger of Canada Bay, Strathfield and Burwood Councils, which is opposed by at least 75% of Canada Bay residents. Amalgamations undermine local democracy and restrict the ability of councils to make decisions which reflect local community concerns. Mergers only benefit big developers.

Stop overdevelopment: restore local planning powers

停止过度发展：恢复地方发展规划权。

The Greens speak for the community, not developers. We don't take developer or corporate donations.

Canada Bay needs more community facilities and open spaces. State Government policies are forcing overdevelopment especially at Rhodes and along Parramatta Road, with a rapid increase of population. We will fight to protect heritage and for more schools and childcare places which have been ignored in the State Government's "Urban Growth" planning model.
