OUR PRIORITIES

CLIMATE 气候

Climate change has started: it has already destroyed half the Great Barrier Reef and impacts agriculture, our health and our cities. Australia must rapidly phase out coal and take strong action to reduce carbon emissions.

TRANSPORT 交通

Only public transport can move Sydney's growing population, reducing congestion and vehicle pollution. WestConnex has not adequately compensated residents, won't resolve traffic congestion, and has a toll on the M4 for the next 43 years!

The NSW government promised and has not delivered rapid transit along Parramatta Road, has privatised the Inner West bus service and will privatise the remaining bus services across Sydney after the election. Privatisations have led to poorer services and increased prices. The Greens support improved public transport options including rail, light rail, trackless trams and high-speed rail.

HEALTH 医疗

The Greens will bring dental services into Medicare, properly fund our hospitals and increase funding for mental health.

ECONOMY 经济

Five years of chaotic Abbott/Turnbull/Morrison management of the economy have left Australians worse off financially than in 2012, with high levels of under-employment and casualisation, particularly for young workers.

The Coalition has closed down Australian car manufacturing, gutted the NBN, forced up power prices, reduced business innovation and cut public services. The Greens will make corporations pay their fair share of tax. Clean energy will lower bills and combat climate change, creating new jobs and new export markets.

COUNCILS 議會

The NSW government has undermined the democracy of local councils. They forced amalgamations against a direct promise. They have mandated massive numbers of new dwellings across Sydney without providing the necessary infrastructure – schools, transport, open space, hospitals.

The government has overridden Council's ability to manage local development. 'Local' planning panels make decisions without community accountability. Council independence must be restored.

INTEGRITY 誠信

The Greens will ban corporate donations that corrupt politics and end corporate influence so politicians are accountable to the community, not just their donors.

EDUCATION 教育

The Greens want full needs-based funding for public schools, not billions spent on stadiums. We will stop TAFE privatisation and restore its accessible, quality training, and will support free university education, stopping deregulation that increases student debt.

HOUSING 住房

The Greens support housing as a basic right, like education – not a commodity for wealthy investors. Many workers with low wages or less secure jobs still cannot achieve home ownership.

Every new residential development must include affordable housing, and the government must build public housing for the homeless and less well off. Tenants' rights must be strengthened and protected. Stop no cause evictions.

REFUGEES 难民

It is legal to seek asylum – the basic human right to flee conflict for safety in another country. The Greens want all offshore detention centres closed and safe pathways for asylum seekers.
