Heath Street Cycleway – Five Dock

We recently completed the construction of the Heath Street Cycleway, Five Dock.

On 19 December 2022, we wrote to you providing an update outlining the steps we were taking to address residents' concerns regarding the cycleway.

In December 2022 we engaged an independent specialist consultant to review and provide advice on the interactions of all users. This review includes residents/pedestrians navigating in and out of properties/carparking, motorists and cyclists using the road and the Regional Cycleway. We thank you for the patience and input in relation to this review.

The report has been received and assessed and we are proposing changes to the current design to deliver a more balanced solution for the surrounding residents and road users. As outlined on the attached plan, it is proposed to remove the separated cycleway. We are inviting the community to attend an onsite meeting to discuss the proposal and provide feedback.


